

**EPIC-MRA CD 13 DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY POLL OF ACTIVE/LIKELY VOTERS
[FREQUENCY REPORT of SURVEY RESPONSES – 700 SAMPLE – ERROR ±3.7%]**

Please Press 1 if you are very certain that you will be going to the polls to vote in the August 7th primary election, Press 2 if you are somewhat certain that you will be going to the polls to vote in the August 7th primary election, Press 3 if you will probably be going to the polls to vote in the August 7th primary election, Press 4 if you have already voted by absentee ballot or if you intend to vote by absentee ballot in the August 7th primary election, and Press 9 if you are not likely to vote in the August 7th election, or if you are not sure.

Press 1 for Abdul El-Sayed, Press 2 for Shri Thanedar, Press 3 for Gretchen Whitmer, or Press 9 if you are undecided.

Which of those six candidates have you either already voted for by absentee ballot, or intend to vote for on election day? Press 1 for Ian Conyers, Press 2 for Coleman Young, Press 3 for Shanelle Jackson, Press 4 for Brenda Jones, Press 5 for Rashida Tlaib, Press 6 for Bill Wild, or Press 9 if you are undecided.
