 15% | Somewhat supports Tea Party movement  
**24% | TOTAL SUPPORT**  
**39% | TOTAL OPPOSE**  
 12% | Somewhat opposes Tea Party movement  
 27% | Strongly opposes Tea Party movement  
 37% | Undecided/Refused
