18% Donald Trump should be the nominee
 70% Some other Republican should be nominated
 12% Undecided/Refused

__13. In the 2024 election, do you think Joe Biden should be nominated by the Democratic Party, or should some other Democrat be nominated?

17% Joe Biden should be the nominee
 71% Some other Democrat should be nominated
 12% Undecided/Refused
