- 33% Will vote by absentee ballot
- 4% Will vote during 9 days of early voting allowed through Sunday before election day
- 5% Undecided/Refused

__04. Overall, would you say that things in our country are generally headed in the right direction, or, have things pretty seriously gotten off on the wrong track?

- 66% Wrong track
- 22% Right direction
- 12% Undecided/Refused

__05. How about in Michigan? Would you say that things in Michigan are generally headed in the right direction, or, have things pretty seriously gotten off on the wrong track?

- 47% Right direction
- 40% Wrong track
- 13% Undecided/Refused

- 40% Joe Biden continuing on as President

- 19% Undecided/Refused

__18. If the election for United States Senate were held today and the candidates were [**ROTATE**] Mike Rogers and Elissa Slotkin, would you vote for [**ROTATE**] Mike Rogers the Republican or Elissa Slotkin the Democrat?

[IF UNDECIDED, ASK: “Well, if the election was being held today, and you had to decide right now, which candidate would you lean toward?” AND CODE BEST RESPONSE]

- 35% Mike Rogers the Republican
- 7% Lean toward Mike Rogers the Republican
- 42% TOTAL VOTE ROGERS**
- 39% Elissa Slotkin the Democrat
- 5% Lean toward Elissa Slotkin the Democrat
- 44% TOTAL VOTE SLOTKIN**
- 14% Undecided/Refused
